

The Court Operations Staff Committee is comprised of Bill Creadon, Chuck O Hanlon, and Colette Polignone.

Chuck O'Halon handles scheduling for Court Reserve, Payroll for Court Attendants, monitors court usage statics, and Round Robins play.

Colette Polignone is the Head Court Attendent responsible for Court Attendants. The Court Operation documents which include Standard Operation Procedure (SOP), Waivers, Signin Sheets, Scheduling and all Operation Documents are maintained by Colette. Human Resource duties are also performed including hiring and training.

Bill Creadon handles court equipment and operational needs that include gates, cameras, and court equipment and supervises on court operations.

Currently, we have hired 4 new Court Attendants that have been trained and assigned to court attendant shifts. We welcome Vince Delfini, Cindy Brighton, Larry Williams, and Carol Lord to our Court Attendant Staff.

We have transitioned the operation of the South Court Paddle Box to the members without Gatekeeper assistance. Both North and South Paddle Boxes are self served by the members. This provides seamless operation at both North and South Paddle Boxes.

The court entrance gates have been modified for better entrance and exiting operations that was developed by Richard Habeshian.

Four new cameras have been installed provided by Live Pickleball Courts that will allow members to review video play that is expected to go live May 1st.

Relocation of cameras will be scheduled for better video play coverage.

The Central Gate for entrance has been installed and the North and South Gates will be fitted with Riot Bars for exit only.

A Security Camera has been installed at the Central Gate that will monitor the area providing video coverage to cover vandal and unauthorized actions.

The Bulletin Board has been relocated to the Central Entrance Area. It has been repaired for water damage and a rain curtain will be added. Drain holes have been added to provide for any needed future drainage needs..

A Lightning Policy has been drafted and will be submitted for approval by the Board.
