1. Call to Order: 5:08pm

Tom Frechette, President; Dave Caswell, Vice-President, Henry Habgood, Treasurer and Margaretta Andrews (phone) were in attendance.

2. A quorum was established

3. The minutes of the August board meeting were approved.

4. Monthly Financials:

- Wells Fargo Checking \$145,377
- Wells Fargo Business Market Savings \$7,205
- Fidelity Account \$204,622

Henry will work on 2026 budget projections for the next meeting.

5. Old Business:

- Nominating Committee – Dave reported that there were 2 candidates who received unanimous approval from the committee. Connie will prepare resumes with photos which will be available to distribute to the membership if necessary.
- Programs Committee met in September, but their report was deferred until Bob O'Leary can be present.
- Operations Committee – Tom noted that the County sent a check for \$1500 for bed tax resulting from last year's Pickleball tournament.
- Maintenance – the landscaping work approved last month on the social areas at the club should begin soon. Tom reported that we need more court dryers and squeegees.
- Dave plans to meet with the gatekeepers in the near future to get their feedback on how things are going and how they can be improved.
- Social Committee – Dave suggested that we hold a Craft Fair in November and perhaps a Taco Tuesday, breakfast for Mothers/Father's Day, and Thanksgiving and Christmas parties. He will work with Margaretta and Mary on plans. Tom thanked Dave for organizing a very successful Labor Day event.

6. New Business:

- The board unanimously voted Mari Colacino in as a new board member – she will replace Dave as our Vice-President.
- The board discussed a proposed youth tournament for local high school children. The proposal was approved, assuming the organizers work independently with no assistance from PBU staff or volunteers. There will be

no charge for the use of up to three courts for the tournament on a date to be determined, not to interfere with busy usage times. Proceeds from the tournament will go to local charities.

- The next regular Board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday October 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:00.

There being no further business to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 5:45pm.
